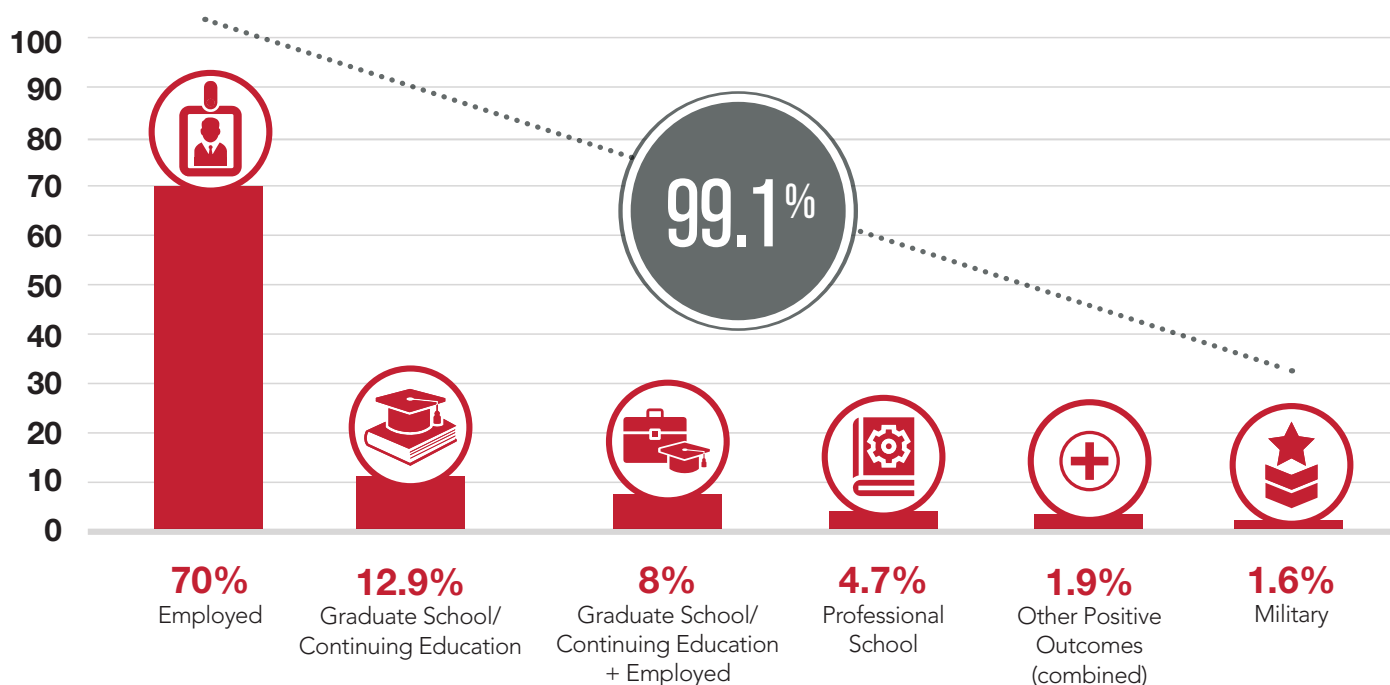

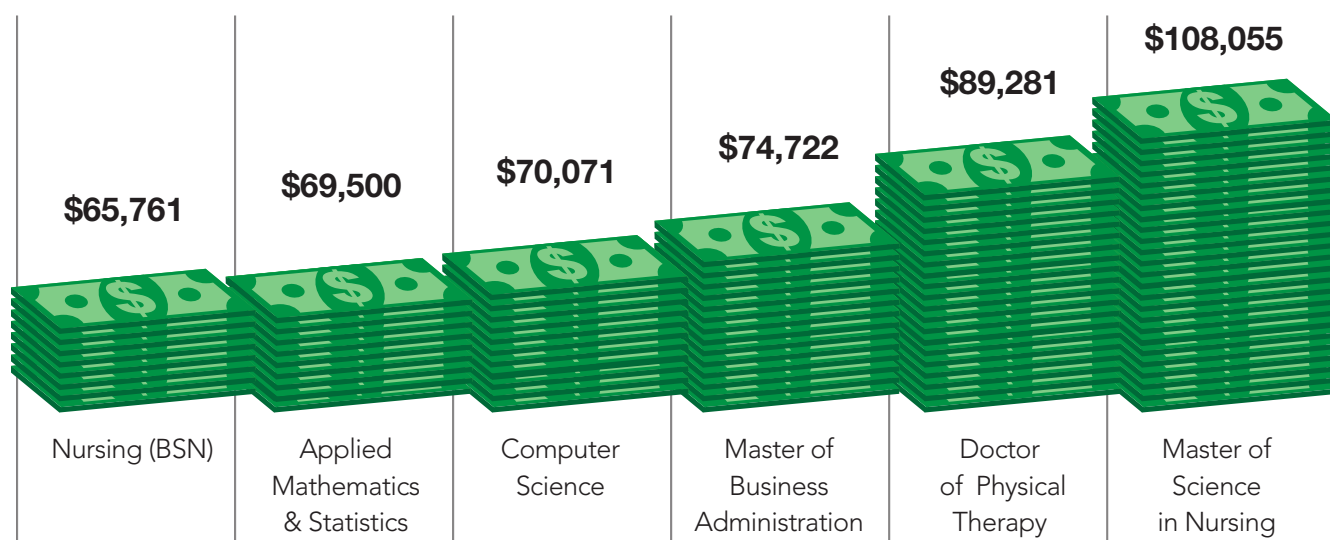
KNOWLEDGE RATE

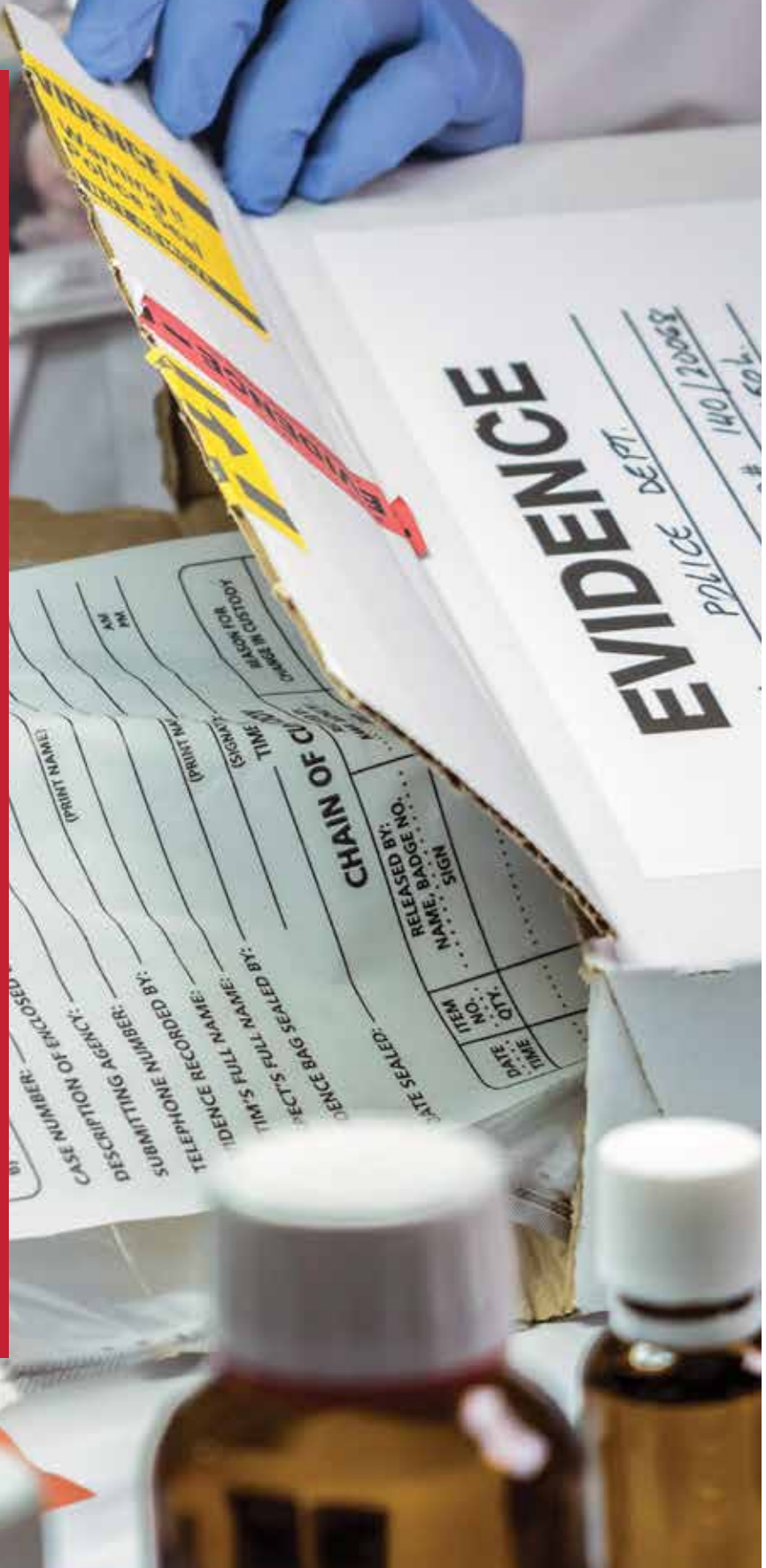
